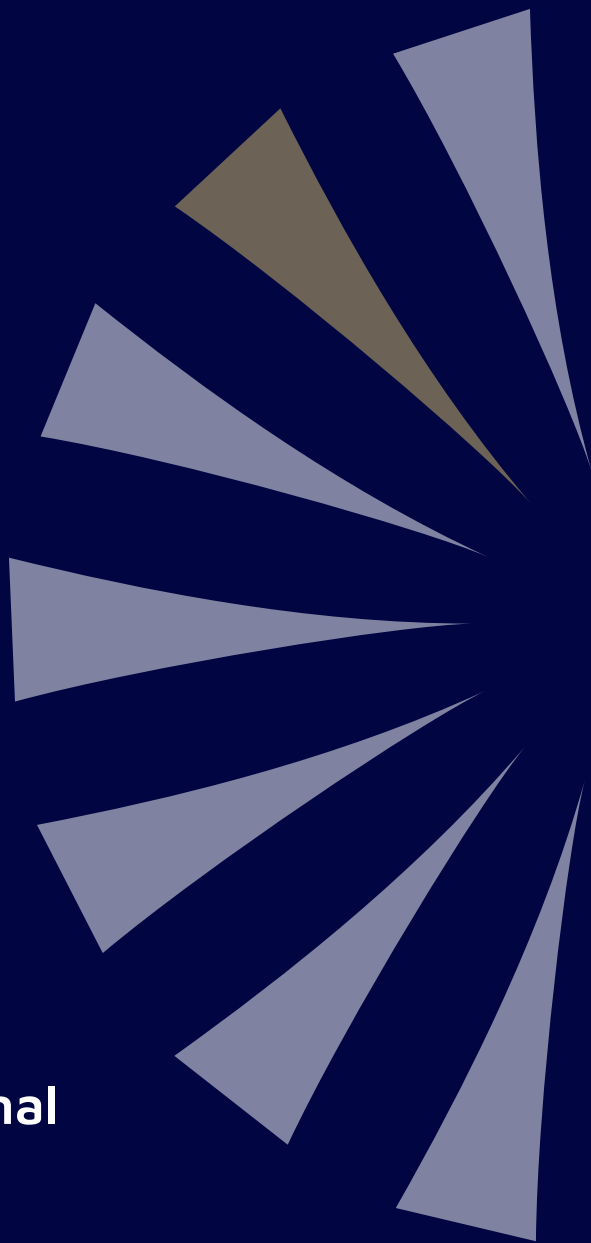

Resources

For the public

- **Information** about psychological trauma and resilience pathways, themed documentation (migration, natural disasters, domestic violence, children and teenagers, grief, terrorist attacks, war, remembrance) and cultural references (books, films, music etc.)
- A **map** of public-sector care provision, including a list of regional psychological trauma centres.

For professionals

- **Sheets** on trauma prevention and identification and how to support and guide people affected by post-traumatic conditions.
- A list of **university and inter-university qualifications** on psychological trauma.

For researchers

- An **annual call** for proposals to fund research grants and a **methodological support unit**.
